








Custom Theme **2.**  Enable custom theme
Create a separate theme for your blog.
Change the layout. Edit the code. Make an
entirely new theme. It's up to you.

Too many options? Mobile User? Copy the Mobile Friendly Code given in the post instead! This will fewer options than the base theme, so be aware when installing! This guide will also follow the Desktop version, but mobile users can still follow along!

How to Install

1. Go to tumblr.com/settings/blog/yourblogname
2. Scroll down until you see "Custom Theme".
3. Click the toggle so it turns blue, then click the grey "Edit theme" button that appears below.
4. Go to Edit HTML under the pre-installed theme's name
5. Select everything with CTRL/⌘ + A then press DEL or Backspace or CTRL/⌘ + X.
6. Go to the code linked in the theme post and press the button that looks like two stacked squares. Then go back to the customize page and press CTRL/⌘ + V. Press "Update Preview" and then "Save".

Tumblr Customization Type Overview

Custom Images are represented by a blank camera or pencil. Pencil means > there's already an image inputted.



Custom Colors are represented by a colored circle. You can drag the slider > around to pick a color or put in a hex code.



Dropdown Menus have a variety of options to determine how your blog looks like. They are represented by a downwards facing v-shape.



Toggle Options have only one option. When the option is activated, the toggle > will turn from grey to blue.



Custom Text is the only area without any unique representation. Input whatever text you want to appear on your blog or use it to insert a file.

Border Type Overview


The blog theme's customization has sections indicated by borders.

Used for post customization.




Used for customization of the date/note count bar and the permalink page.



Night Mode

Normally, a user's experience will have the theme appear in night mode depending on OS or browser settings. If you want your blog to automatically be in night mode regardless of user settings, scroll down to "night mode by default" and change the option from "no" to "yes".



Background Image

If you want your blog's background to be an image, find this setting >

This will generate a full-sized background for your blog's theme. If you rather have a repeating background, scroll down and find this option >

Then change the input from "yes" to "no".




Click on the gear on the top left-hand side >

The final step is to find this setting. Highlight the link with CTRL/⌘ + A and then press DEL or Backspace. Then paste in your uploaded font with CTRL/⌘ + V. >

Enabling the Side area

Change this from "no" to "yes" to enable your sidebar link menu >

show sidebar

Changes position of the side area from left hand side to right hand side >

side area position

Determines if you want to keep the menu of links open >

keep link menu open

yes ▾

Moves the pagination to be below the sidebar. Stays in the side area even if you have no sidebar enabled! >

Customizing the sidebar



For now, the sidebar is just a bare links menu. If you want to add more sections to the sidebar you can toggle these settings.

show blog header image








Non-image custom cursors

Both cursor types have plenty of options for customization without providing an image. >




Tooltip Arrow
